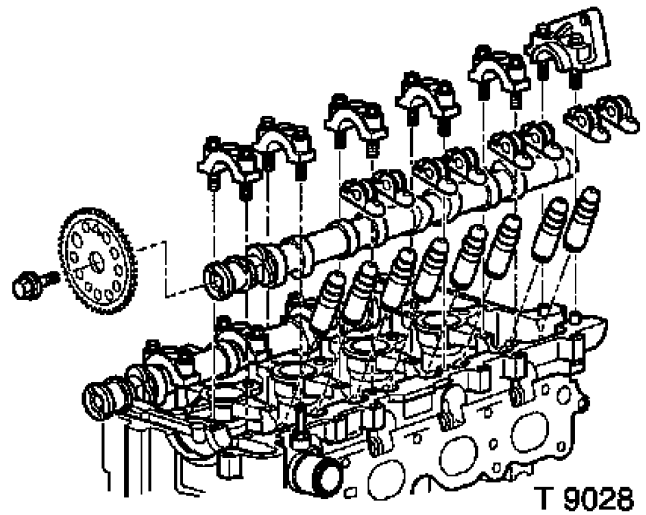


Camshaft and Cam Followers

The cast iron camshafts are driven by the timing chain and rotate in bearings, which are formed directly in the cylinder head and the bearing caps. The cams open the valves through finger followers, which pivot on automatic hydraulic adjusters. The finger followers are equipped with rollers to reduce friction and noise against the cams.
