
Weatherstrip for Front Roof Frame, Replace



- 1. Remove soft top or hard top
- 2. Remove weatherstrip (1)
 - Cut back head of 2x plastic retainer (2) flush with front roof frame on left side and right side
 Note: Visibly mark position of 2x plastic retainer for later reference.
 - · Pull off weatherstrip




3. Remove all traces of adhesive residue




- 4. Apply masking tape to front roof frame on both top corners adjacent to soft top or hard top mounting brackets
 - Apply tape 200 mm each side of mounting bracket Note: This is for marking optimum position of weatherstrip location.
- 5. Prime adhesive area
 - Apply recommended primer to complete weatherstrip path


 Allow to cure
- 6. Locate new weatherstrip and temporarily tape in position
- 7. Install soft top or hard top
- 8. Position weatherstrip to optimum sealing position
 - · Mark position on previously applied masking tape
- 9. Remove soft top or hard top
- Punch 2x 5 mm hole in weatherstrip for 2x plastic retainer
 Note: Punch holes should not conflict with position of old plastic retainers.
- **11.** Partially remove protective tape from weatherstrip
 - Remove protective tape from S section (1) on left side and right side
 - Align weatherstrip to previously marked position and apply pressure



- **12.** Secure weatherstrip to front roof frame between 2x soft top or hard top mounting brackets
 - Remove protective tape, position weatherstrip then apply pressure
- 13. Secure weatherstrip to 2x A pillar
 - Align front weatherstrip (1) with rear weatherstrip (2)
 - Remove protective tape, position weatherstrip then apply pressure



14. Apply recommended adhesive sealant between front roof frame (1) and weatherstrip (2)
 Note: Apply adhesive sealant along seam where arrowed.



- **15.** Drill 2x hole for 2x plastic retainer
 - Note position of 2x hole in weatherstrip
 - Use 5 mm drill
 - · Drill to maximum depth of 8 mm
- 16. Install 2x new plastic retainers
 - Apply recommended adhesive sealant to 2x hole
- 17. Apply pressure evenly to weatherstrip, then allow to cure for a minimum of two hours
- 18. Install soft top or hard top
