
**Important:** A four-post hoist must be used to raise the vehicle when removing the engine undertray. The vehicle can be moved to a two-post hoist for other operations if required.


- 1. Remove engine undertray
  - · Raise vehicle
  - · Remove 13x bolt, 13x washer

Important: Observe relevant environmental requirements when disposing of used oil.

- 2. Release transmission housing cover (1) from transmission
  - Position suitable collecting container
  - Remove 8x bolt (arrowed)
- 3. Remove transmission housing cover from transmission
  - Use KM-J-37228

     Note: Take care not to damage mating surfaces.






**4.** Remove oil collection pipe (1) from transmission


**Note:** Oil collection pipe removed to avoid damage when cleaning mating surfaces.

- 5. Clean mating surfaces
- 6. Install oil collection pipe to transmission
  - Push on
- 7. Install new transmission housing cover to transmission
  - Apply sealing compound to mating surface of transmission housing cover
     Note: Do not apply sealing compound to shaded area (1) as this could cause fluid guide pipe (2) to become blocked.
- 8. Install 8x bolt 25 Nm



- 9. Check transmission oil level and correct as necessary
- 10. Install engine undertray
  - Install 13x bolt, 13x washer
- 11. Lower vehicle
