
Piston and or Connecting Rod (one), Replace (piston and connecting rod removed)

Note: Piston and connecting rod removed - see operation "Pistons and Connecting Rods, Remove and Install"

- Detach the piston from the connecting rod.
 Note: Note the installation position of the connecting rod and the piston.
 - Remove the snap ring (1).
 - · Press out the piston pin.
- 2. Attach the piston to the connecting rod.

 Important: The arrow on the piston crown points towards the timing chain end of the engine.
 - · Apply engine oil to the piston pin.
 - Press in the piston pin (2).
 - · Install the snap ring.



- 3. Install the piston rings.
 - Use new piston rings.
 Note: During installation of the second piston ring (Napier ring): "Punkt" (= point or dot) identification faces upwards.
 - Adjust the piston ring gap.
 - First piston ring (rectangular-

- section ring) in position
- Second piston ring (Napier ring) in position
- Intermediate ring of the oil scraper ring in position, steel band rings of the oil scraper ring in position
